

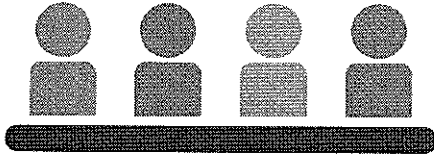

The Center for Nonprofit Management and Hands On Nashville have partnered to form OnBoard, a program to train and place community leaders who want to serve on nonprofits' boards of directors.

Lewis Lavine, president of CNM, said OnBoard will educate interested volunteers on governance and nonprofit leadership skills, identify their areas of interest and then connect them with groups looking to fill board spots.

“In the last year, Hands On Nashville placed or referred a record 34,000 volunteers to community service agencies,” said Brian Williams, Executive Director of Hands On Nashville. “We are honored to partner with CNM to create a formal program” to prepare board members for those nonprofits.

Participants in OnBoard sessions will have to pay a \$295 fee for the training and assessment process. CNM will host its first program session April 17.
